Remember, if your club has less than \$25,000 combined receipts in both your administration and activities (project) accounts, you can file the e-file postcard. Just go to the following website: <http://epostcard.form990.org>. Follow the directions from there. If you have trouble completing the form you may need to file a 990 and mail it to the IRS.

On a brighter note, the first cabinet meeting in Visalia was a lot of fun and a financial success as well. We covered all our expenses and had a few dollars left over. 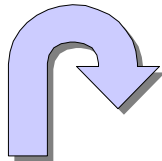

## Something to Remember!

Inter-Club Activities: The Visitation Committee shall promote visitations among Clubs of the District and offer awards annually. In order to foster **LIONS CLUB** visitations in District 4-A2, the following "Good Faith" standards shall be observed:

No District 4-A2 equipment may be taken at any time.

Items of club equipment may be "borrowed" during regular Club meetings. Meetings considered special are: Ladies Nights and District, Regional or Zone meetings. Items may be taken only during the meeting and not before it has been called to order nor after its adjournment.

Items may be taken in a gentlemanly manner. No physical force may be used.

Items may not be traded to another club or taken outside the District. It shall be the responsibility of the borrowing Club to keep safe and protect all items borrowed while in their possession.

The borrowing Club shall notify the losing Club of its possession of equipment within a 14-day period. The losing Club shall have thirty (30) days within which to regain its property. If not redeemed within that period, the borrowing Club must return the property within ninety (90) days.

Although the borrowed equipment is of great value, the redemption value shall be limited to modest fines.

Members, let's continue the camaraderie that **Lions** all over the world enjoy, but let's remember a few basic rules as outlined in the District 4-A2 Constitution and Bylaws which begin on page 184 of the current district directory. Let's make it *Fun but Fair & Within the Rules!*

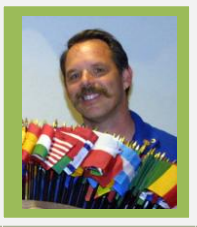

### THINGS I LEARNED AT THE USA-CANADA FORUM

In a session on whether and how to incorporate you're Lions Club, one participant asked about how to answer some questions the IRS had asked her by e-mail. The presenter focused on a correct answer regarding the status of clubs as non-profits rather than charitable.

THEN another participant got up and pointed out that the IRS will NOT contact you by e-mail for any purpose. You can file things at the IRS website, but they will not e-mail you for information. In later discussion, other Lions confirmed having received this scam. Over half of them had supplied the information.

When I shared this with Gov. Betty, she asked that I e-mail you (The District Webmaster) as this information might be good info for all Lions Clubs in the district.
