Page 4:

Contest Policy:

The (15) fifteen District Contest Chairs abide by the rules and operate the District contest for the Committee. "NO OTHER LION SHOULD PROVIDE INFORMATION OR RULE ON ANY STUDENT SPEAKER CONTEST MATTERS."

Page 8:

"Zone, Region, District, Area, and MD4 contest dates MUST be SET and ANNOUNCED by the CLUB level contest. FAILURE to complete the contest BY THE REQUIRED DATE shall DISQUALIFY the winners from further competition that year." "NO contest dates and times, once announced, shall be changed unless ALL CONTESTANTS ARE GIVEN A WEEKS NOTICE."

The District 4C2 Contest will be held at the Windsor Community Center (directions will be available at the February Cabinet Meeting) Saturday, April 12, 2008, at 1:45 p.m. Doors locked at 2 p.m.
