Forms should be completed on line or mailed right away!!

- If you complete the Monthly Membership Report (MMR) <u>on line</u> with Lions Clubs International, they will not mail you a printed paper copy of the PU101. You will need to complete the PU101 on line, or you can request one from Lions Clubs International, or you can contact me (I have a very limited supply of printed paper copies PU101s).
- If you complete your Monthly Membership Report (MMR) <u>by mail</u> with Lions Clubs International, they should have mailed your club Secretary a printed paper copy of the PU101 to be completed. For a printed paper copy of the PU101s, you will need to mail a copy to Lions Clubs International and a copy to me.

Club Officer Training

Officer training is very important for you to attend and the district is in the planning stages right now. Dates will be posted on our district web page (<u>www.4a2lions.com</u>) and your clubs should be hearing from your zone chairs soon. The officers who should attend should be: the newly elected Presidents, all Vice-Presidents, Secretaries, Treasurers, & Club Directors. Now for the Club Treasurers, as we wind down this year, it is impor-



tant that you have your books "audited" by someone within your club that has an eye for detail. Be sure that you have receipts for all the bills paid and that your bank accounts are reconciled. The "auditors" will need to give a report to your board stating that they found everything to be in order and funds were spent appropriately and from the correct account.



If your club brought in more than \$25,000 in gross receipts from all activities, you will need to file a form 990 with the IRS before November 15, 2010. If your gross income (all money received from any source – admin and project) you can do an e-file postcard and meet the filing requirements. This, too, must be done by November 15th. The website for the e postcard is <u>http://</u> <u>epostcard.form990.org</u>.
