Whole army vaccinated within a year. Death rate dropped to 19%
 - Women played a major part in the war. Women took over the farms and the factories. They made up for all of the loss through exports. Also they fought beside their husbands.

DISTRICT MEETING OF APRIL 23RD -24TH, 2022

GOOD MORNING DISTRICT GOVERNOR DAVID, VICE DISTRICT GOVERNORS FALGINI AND CHRISTY, VISITING DIGNITARIES, MEMBERS OF THE CABINET, FELLOW LIONS MEMBERS, LEOS AND GUESTS.

THIS IS THE LAST REPORT FOR THIS CABINET YEAR. WE HAD SOME UPS AND DOWNS THIS YEAR.. SEVERAL CLUBS SUBMITTED VISITATION FORMS THAT DID NOT GET COUNTED. THIS IS BECAUSE THEY DID NOT HAVE THE REQUIRED NUMBER OF MEMBERS MAKING THE VISITATION. TO MAKE IT AN OFFICIAL VISITATION AN EXAMPLE WOULD BE IF YOU ARE IN THE MEDIAM CLUB SIZE WITH 20 TO AND INCLUDING 35 MEMBERS, YOU NEED 4 MEMBERS ATTENDING AND SIGNING THE VISITATION FORM FOR IT TO BE COUNTED AS AN OFFICIAL VISITION. OR IN THE SMALL CLUB AND YOUR CLUB MEMBERSHIP IS UP TO AND INCLUDING 19 MEMBERS YOU NEED 3 MEMBERS ATTENDING AND SIGNING THE VISITATION FORM FOR IT TO BE COUNTED AS AN OFFICIAL VISITATION.

IN THE SMALL CLUBS, WE ENDED WITH A TOTAL OF 5 CLUBS HAVING SUBMITTED VISITATION FORMS. IN 4TH PLACE IS VISALIA CHARTER OAK WITH 200 POINTS; THIRD PLACE IS DELANO WITH 619.8 POINTS; IN SECOND PLACE IS BAKERSFIELD SPORTS WITH 730 POINTS AND IN 1ST PLACE IS VISALIA SUNSET WITH 2,080 POINTS.

IN THE MEDIUM CLUBS, WE ENDED TEN CLUBS COMPETING. IN 9TH PLACE WE HAVE A TIE WITH VISALIA SEQUOIA AND VISALIA HOST WITH 100 POINTS EACH; 8TH PLACE IS FRESNO HOST WITH 282.2 POINTS; 7TH PLACE BAKERSFIELD HOST 315 POINTS; 6TH IS McFARLAND WITH 1,508 POINTS; 5TH PLACE IS CLOVIS COUNTRY WITH 1,942 POINTS; 4TH PLACE ROSEDALE HIWAY HAS 2,120 POINTS; IN 3RD PLACE IS VISALIA PRIDE WITH 2,157; 2ND PLACE, AND ONLY 2 POINTS AHEAD OF VISALIA PRIDE IS HANFORD BREAKFAST WITH 2,159 POINTS AND IN 1ST PLACE IS RICHGROVE WITH 9,682.8 POINTS.

IN THE LARGE CLUBS ONLY FOUR CLUBS COMPETED; IN 4TH PLACE IS VISALIA BRAKFAST WITH 106 POINTS; IN 3RD PLACE IS BUTTONWILLOW WITH 210 POINTS; IN 2ND PLACE IS SELMA CENTRAL VALLEY WITH 656 POINTS AND IN 1ST PLACE IS CUTLER OROSI WITH 2,199.5 POINTS.

FOR THE LEOS WE HAVE ONLY THE MC FARLAND LEOS WHO SUBMITTED VISITATION FORMS THIS LAST YEAR SO THEY ARE IN 1ST PLACE WITH 4,278 POINTS.
